

## Learner B (SLD)

Learner B is a Key Stage 4 pupil who has an unidentified genetic disorder, her development has been defined over the last few years as being on the autistic spectrum.

Learner B has a short concentration and attention span and therefore accesses intervention sessions 4-5 times a week for short 5 minute 1-1 sessions

In the autumn term Learner B's target was to recognise her own name (R S9). Learner B used the choose it maker programme to select her own name from 2, then from 3, then from 4 different names and so on. As the weeks progressed the other names on the choose it maker programme were chosen to look similar to her own name so that we were sure she was choosing her own name.

Once we were sure Learner B could recognise her name on the programme we started to leave her name in different places within the school environment. Learner B became confident recognising her name throughout the school.

At the end of the autumn term 2017 (over 13 weeks) Learner B can now recognise her name on her coat peg, on her tray and on school displays.
